Prairie Roots Co-op Agro would like to share the following information regarding COVID-19:

Prairie Roots Co-op Agro Team:

- Starting in October all Prairie Roots Co-op Staff are required to wear masks inside our retails. Customers are encouraged to wear masks, but not mandated unless by orders of MB Public Health.
- The Co-op Agro Team will continue to meet with customers at our retails or on farm (with customer request/permission). We will also continue to support our customers by email, phone, text, as we help you develop 2021 Crop Plans.

Product Supply:

- We remain focused on delivering the products our customers need for a safe and successful 2021 growing season.
- Suppliers have developed plans to supply products we need for the 2021 Crop Year.
- Should the situation change we will be transparent.

On site changes for Prairie Roots Co-op Agro:

- COVID-19 protocols – Marquette Agro
- Customers will observe a STOP sign upon arriving to our compound gates
- Vehicles will be prompted to report directly to Fertilizer Shed or Seed Treater
- Drivers - Stay within 5 feet of their vehicles at all times
- Drivers - Observe Provincial Social Distancing Guidelines of 1 - 2 meters at all times when interacting with our staff, turn off your vehicle to assist with clear communication
- Requirement for Drivers to sign a Loadout Ticket has been SUSPENDED
- If requested, we will provide a copy of the loadout ticket to the Driver
- Otherwise it will be mailed to customer along with their next statement.
- Please use phone/text/email to contact a Prairie Roots Co-op Team Member in advance of all pickups, which allows us to prepare your order in advance
- In all other situations, vehicles are to line up at the Fertilizer Shed or Seed Treater and wait for a Prairie Roots Co-op Team Member to communicate their request for product
